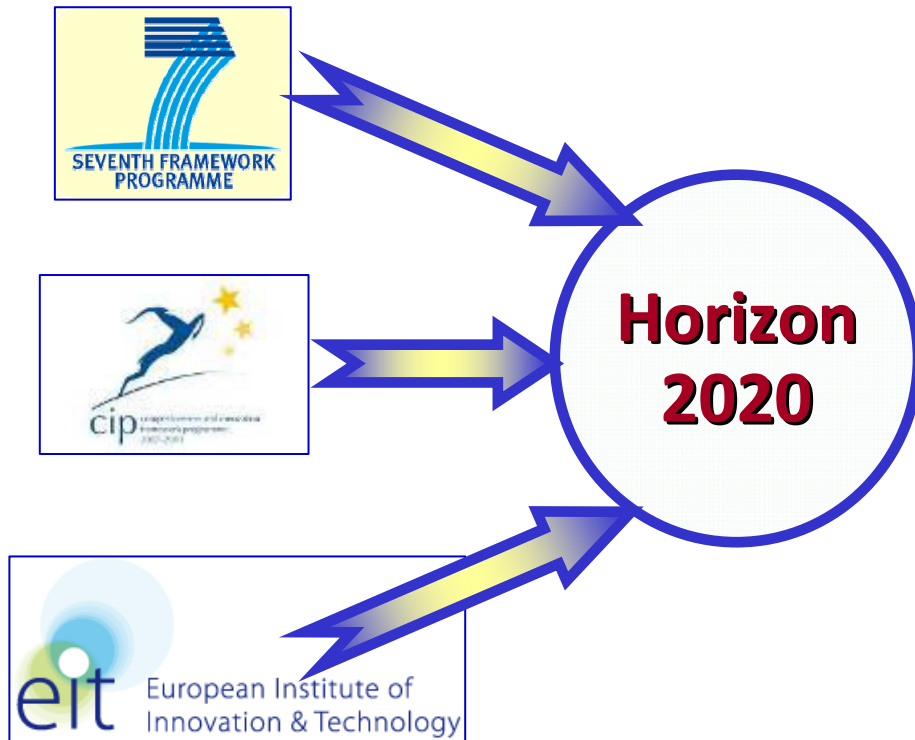

# What is Horizon 2020

- **A core part of *Europe 2020*, Innovation Union & European Research Area:**
  - Responding to the economic crisis to invest in future jobs and growth
  - Addressing people's concerns about their livelihoods, safety and environment
  - Strengthening the EU's global position in research, innovation and technology
- **Initial Commission proposal for a €80 billion research and innovation funding programme (2014-2020);**  
→ **final budget agreement: just over €70 billion**

# Horizon 2020: What's new

**Horizon 2020 Budget: 70 B€**



## ■ Excellent Science (32 %)

*ERC, Marie Curie actions, FETs, Research infrastructures*

## ■ Industrial Leadership (22 %)

*Leadership in Enabling Technologies (ICT, Nanotechnology materials, Biotechnology, Production Technologies, ...), Access to risk finance, Innovation in SMEs*

## ■ Societal challenges (38 %)

*Health & Ageing, Energy, Transport, Resource Efficiency, Climate Challenge, ...*

# Horizon 2020: Not business as usual!

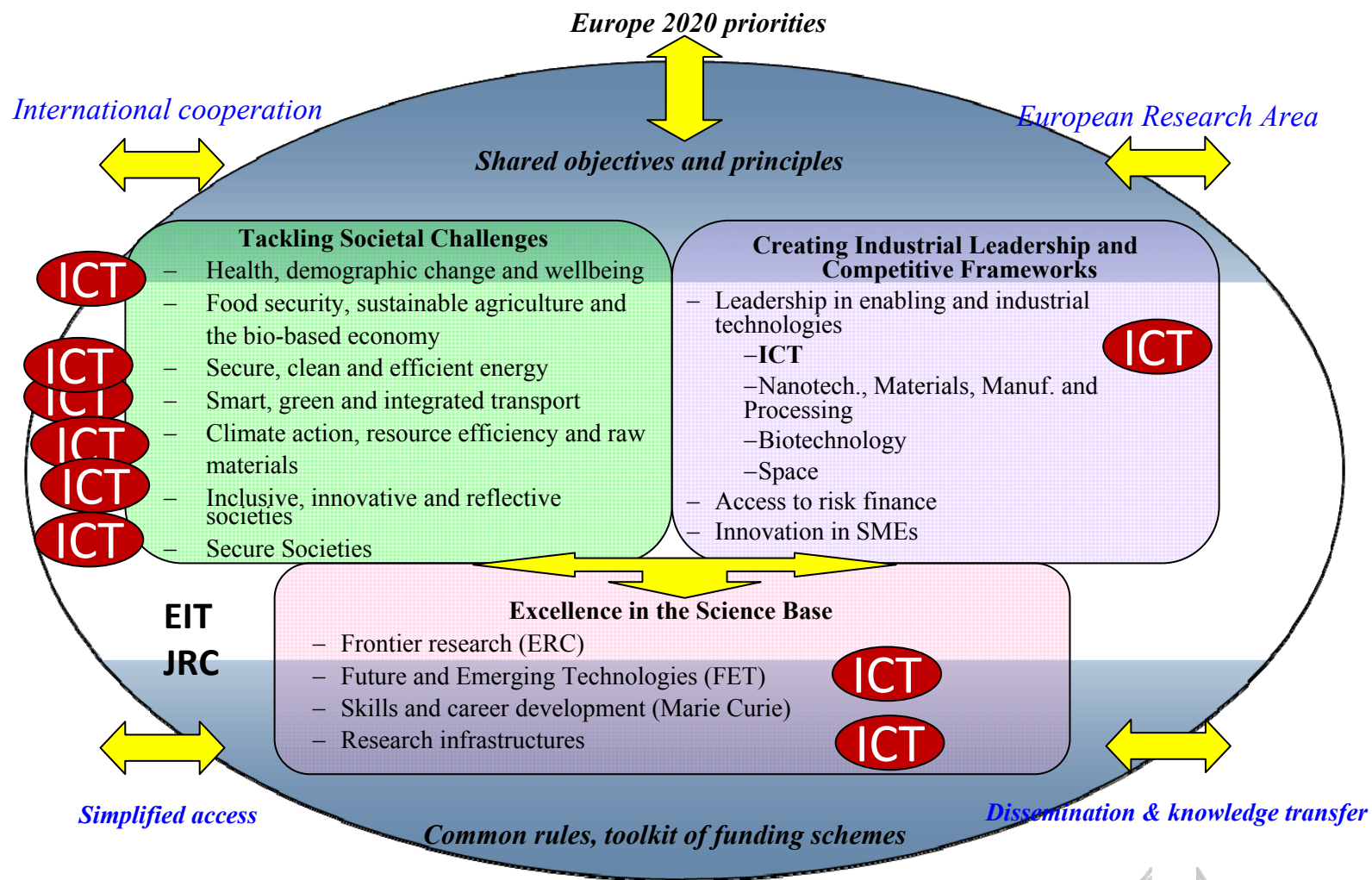
## Radical Simplification!

- A single set of participation rules
- Only two funding rates for all beneficiaries and activities:
  - ✓ 100% for research actions - 70% for "closer to the market" actions
  - ✓ a **single flat rate for overheads**
- Simpler accounting principles, shorter time-to-grant, fewer and better targeted controls and audits, etc.

## But also:

- Coverage of the full innovation chain: from basic research to technology development, demonstration, validation and to the market
- Dedicated innovation support activities, including dedicated actions targeting innovative SMEs

# New ICT opportunities for Greece!

- **Greece is doing well in ICT FP7 – overall, 8<sup>th</sup> funding position with more than 4% of the budget share – Good presence in:**
  - ✓ e-Infrastructures, FET;
  - ✓ several ICT enabling technologies: network technologies, robotics, software technologies, embedded systems, photonics
  - ✓ several Societal Challenges (in particular Health)
- **ICT in Horizon 2020: New opportunities and new Challenges**
  - ✓ In particular for SMEs (innovation!)
  - ✓ Especially, in combination with Structural (Regional) funds
